Public Meeting on The Hospital Committee for the Livermore-Pleasanton Areas', doing business as ValleyCare Health System, Request for Modification of Condition

The California Attorney General will conduct a public meeting on August 23, 2018, beginning at 10:00 a.m., at 5565 W. Las Positas Blvd, Suite 150, Pleasanton, California 94588. The purpose of the public meeting is to receive comments on ValleyCare Health System's request for the modification IV(b) of the Attorney General's Decision issued on April 7, 2015. The modification seeks to eliminate the requirement to maintain and provide "Acute psychiatric services, including a minimum of 14 beds and geriatric behavioral health services at ValleyCare Memorial Hospital," located in Livermore, California.
